You will be added to a google classroom for your registration class. Every morning there will be a question to be completed that shows your attendance. This will open at 9am and close at 10am. You can access this question from both the stream of your google classroom or in 'Classwork' under 'Attendance Date'.

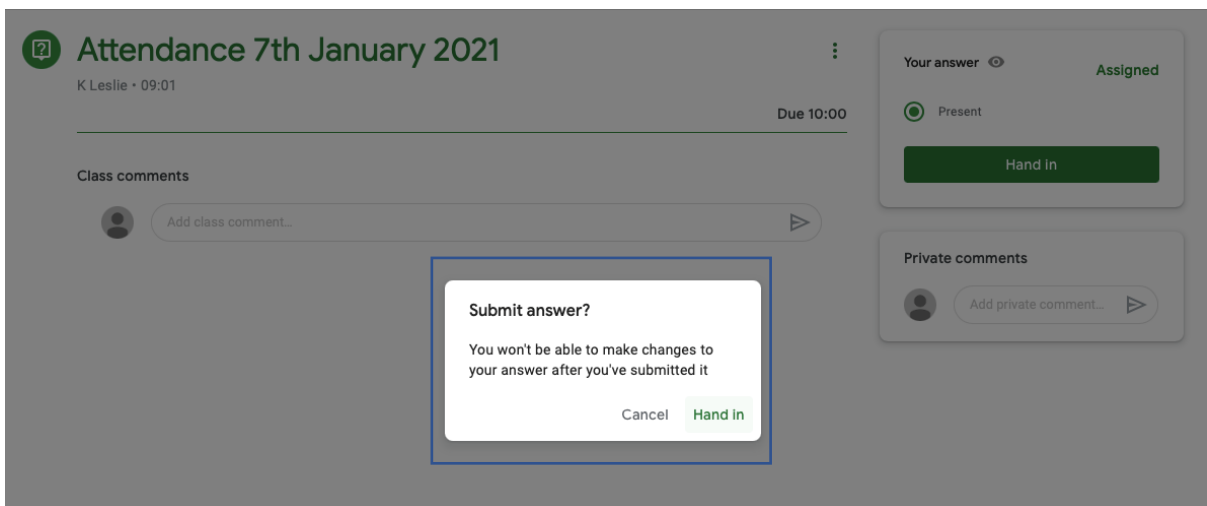
Click on the question to open the assignment and select present:

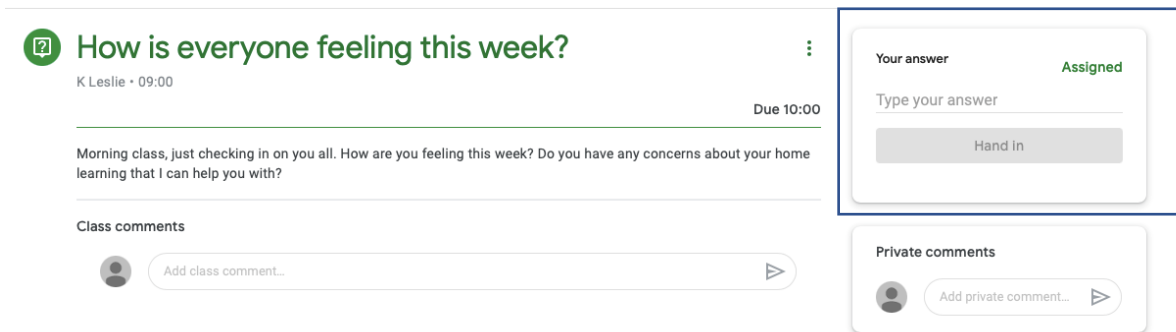
Once you have clicked present you will be able to 'Hand in' your answer to show you have registered for the day.
