Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you have had an enjoyable summer and have been able to get out and about to enjoy the lovely weather we've had.

We very much look forward to welcoming back all our learners and staff and we extend a special welcome to our new first year pupils. We start this new session with great anticipation of great things to come for our school and community.

This newsletter contains some important information regarding the return to school on Tuesday 17th August 2021, the school day starting at 8.25am as usual.

Covid-19:

I am sure that we all welcome the move to Tier 0 of Covid-19 mitigations. However, we still have to be mindful that the virus is still around us and we cannot afford to drop our guard. The latest Scottish Government guidance for schools stipulates that face coverings must be worn by everyone in school, unless you are exempt, and that sanitising hands and workstations and one metre distancing between pupils and staff must continue for at least the next 6 weeks.

At Ellon Academy we plan to continue with our one-way system, but from Tuesday 17th August, all pupils should enter the school via the pupil doors.

This session Senior Leaders will be running a 'Late Gate' at reception for all pupils who arrive after 8.25am and you will be contacted if your child/children are persistently late for school.

Our pupils will also be required to stick to their designated gathering areas prior to registration, at break and at lunchtime times as follows:

- S1 - Canteen
- S2/3 - Sunken Social Area
- S4 - Street and Canteen
- S5/6 - Respective Social Areas

You will have also received a letter from Susan Webb, Director of Public Health NHS Grampian last week, in which she gives advice about Covid-19 and encourages all young people to take a twice weekly lateral flow test on our return to school. Test kits have already been offered to

Pupils/Parents/Carers and continue to be available via the school office with collection being during lunchtime by pupils.

School Pitches:

I am delighted to let you know that the reparation work for our school pitches has been completed and we will be able to use them properly for the first time since the school opened 6 years ago. We are grateful to Aberdeenshire Council for their support in getting this vital work done.

School Uniform Reminder for Parents/Carers. Expectations for August 2021:

As stated prior to the summer, we expect our learners to come to school in school uniform which gives a sense of pride in the school, helps to identify intruders in the campus and supports all learners to feel equal in what they are wearing. We will be in touch if these standards begin to slip. Also, we can now use PE changing rooms, so pupils are asked to bring their PE kits on PE days to change into for their gym classes.

It is important that pupils identify with their school and wearing school uniform instils a sense of pride in being part of the school. This ensures that pupils can come to school in their 'work' clothes and can be easily identified as Ellon Academy learners.

- Plain black skirt or trousers/black jeans, jeans style trousers, black leggings or jeggings
- Ellon Academy school tie worn with a plain white collared/button down shirt
- A plain black jumper/cardigan or a plain black 'Ellon Academy' jumper
- Footwear**
 - Black Shoes or trainers (black trainers with colour accents are acceptable)
 - Optional**
 - A plain black or 'Ellon Academy' fleece/jumper
 - A black blazer (optional)
- Clothes with patterns or other colours
- Joggers/tracksuit bottoms/faded black jeans
- Advertising brands/logos on jumpers/cardigans
- T-shirts or round neck tops instead of a collared shirt
- Sportswear (except for in PE classes and pupils must change back into school dress after PE)
- Wearing outdoor jackets, fleeces, hoodies or coats in class or registration
- Hats off and hoods down in school

A change of clothing and footwear for PE is essential.
We would recommend that you wear outer jackets in school dress code colours, black, blue or burgundy.
