***Please note that no subscription will be asked until after October holidays as schools cannot compete against other schools in line with education guidance during this time. EASA will offer training/extracurricular clubs for free until restrictions have eased and competitions have started up again at school level. ***

Annual subscription is £30. Pupils may undertake any sport and, if selected for a team, will be asked to attend fixtures in our school and in a wide range of other competitions. The money collected by EASA goes towards bookings of facilities, subsidises bus and entry fees, and other expenses. Hardship grants are given to pupils who may struggle to pay membership fees. Parents/guardians should contact their child's guidance teacher for this to be processed.
