Canteen Concerns:

As you can imagine, our canteen has been much busier this week after a spell of wet weather. Therefore, we stress how important it is for all pupils to have their National Entitlement Cards with them. The queues are very busy, and they are further held up when a significant number of pupils don't have their card. This results in the member of canteen staff having to search the pupil's name on the system, causing further delay. Some pupils have no money on their cards, so then staff must take paper notes regarding what they have chosen to eat and drink with the costs added. This results in further work for the staff who then must check each individual pupils' account to see if it has been topped up and then they deduct what the child has chosen. If a pupil has no money on their account, they will only be offered a meal (no crisps, juice, biscuits, puddings etc.)

If you are having difficulty ordering a new card or topping up your child's card on-line, please call the Academy office on 01358 281150 to ask for advice and support.

The queues would be so efficient if everyone had their card and/or PIN.

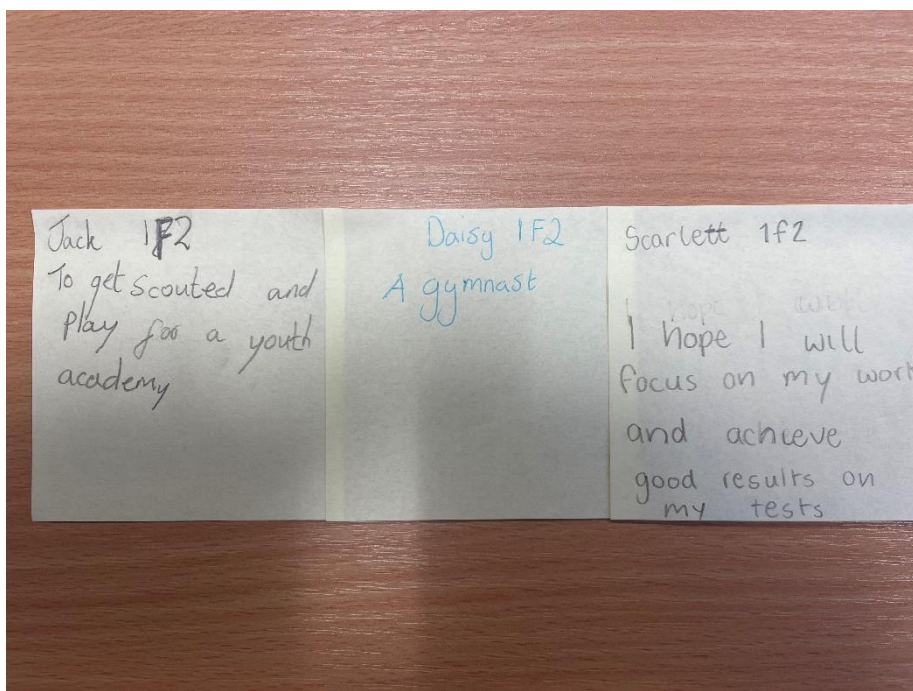
Pupil Achievement:

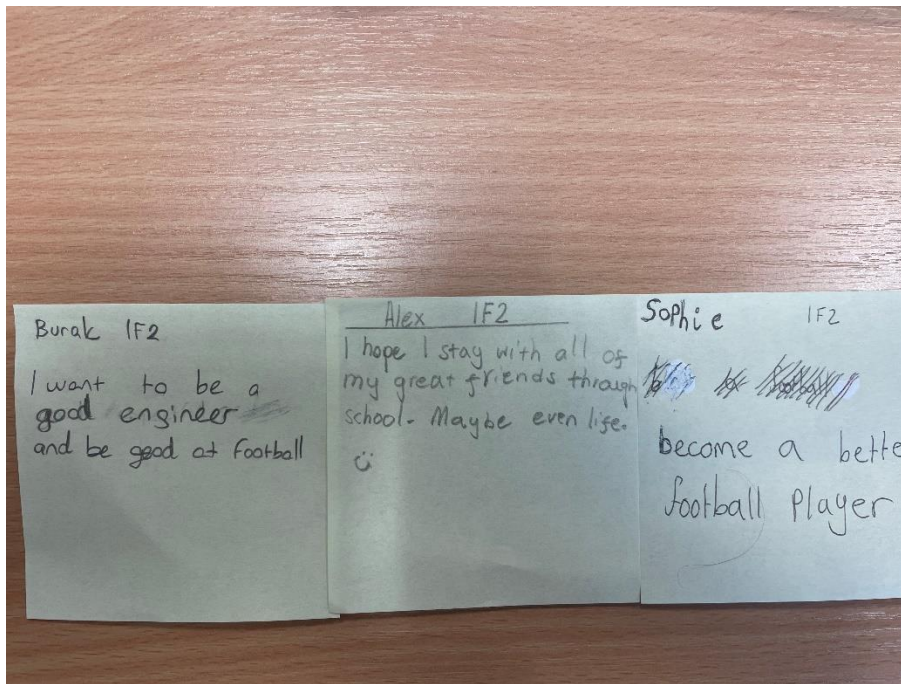
