Remote Learning from Home in January 2021 Up-date

Learning from Home:

Our staff continue to work remotely, planning, preparing and reviewing on-line remote learning for our pupils. Next week's Learning Schedules have been sent home to all parents/carers and pupils today, one for S1/2/3 and another for S4/5/6. We are also happy to support families with ICT to support learning from home, so please get in touch if you require a device for your child to access during lockdown.

The provision for children of key workers and vulnerable children continues in school and if your circumstances change, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

This is Ellon Academy's stance on remote learning, which is in line with that of Education Scotland:

*Remote learning includes a combination of 'live' interactions between teacher and learner **and** learning which takes place away from the direct presence of the teacher.*

'Live' interactions may include:

- *Scheduled dates/times when teachers will be online to respond to questions, queries, etc. posed by pupils, for example, on Google Classroom streams*
- *Scheduled Glow Meet/Teams sessions for Q&A with teachers to answer questions, consolidate learning, and the delivery of key messages on how learners can improve future learning*
- *Delivery of lessons or part lessons online in real time by class teacher/lead teacher/external teacher*

Remote learning works well when supported through pre-recorded lessons, presentations (some narrated), lesson notes, diagrams and links to useful websites for learners to revisit.

According to the Remote Learning advice prepared by Education Scotland, in partnership with the Covid-19 Education Recovery Group (CERG), remote learning activities may include – reading, doing, creating & inventing, problem-solving, observing and investigating with some of the best learning examples not requiring technology. National guidance is that learners should not engage in online learning for the entirety of their school day. Learning may include activities such as research tasks, project work, practical opportunities, discussions and other activities that can be carried out away from a digital device.

Faculties have worked collegiately to discuss, agree and develop a remote learning plan, lessons, activities, resources and assessments to allow your child(ren) to make progress in their learning away from school. Staff are continually improving practice and being supported to do so by respective line managers.

We appreciate your support and understanding as we all learn in these challenging times.

If you have any concerns regarding progress or wellbeing for your young person their Principal Teacher of Guidance remains your first point of contact.
