Learner Conversations:

Learner conversations with senior pupils regarding their progress were on going prior to Easter. Just a reminder that if your child/children are working on National 4 courses, there is no requirement from the SQA for assessments at N4 level, just N5, Higher and Advanced Higher.



Subject Choice and New Timetable Up-date:

Our Principal Teachers of Guidance have been working with pupils and parents/carers regarding their subject choices, if there have been issues with courses and any clashes which may occur. Mr Cowie DHT has been working hard and we now have a working draft of our new timetable, considering the increased number of pupils indicating that they plan to stay on at school next session.

Covid -19 Up-date – Every Mitigation Matters:

Although Secondary schools are back full time, with no social distancing, we remain in Level 4 nationally and we continue to do all we can to minimise the spread of infection to keep our school open, so here are our continued mitigations:

S1/2/3 pupils to enter and leave the school via the Pupil Doors:

S4/5/6 and G7 Hub/ASL Transport pupils to enter and leave the school via the Foyer/Reception Doors

- All pupils and staff are expected to wear face coverings at all times (not when eating/drinking) unless they
 are medically exempt
- Our one-way system is still in operation.
- All pupils and staff to hand sanitise on arrival.
- Pupils can gather in their designated year group zones prior to registration. See below:

- o S1 Canteen
- o S2/3 Sunken Social Area and Street
- S4 Canteen
- S5 S5 Social Area on the First Floor
- S6 S6 Social Area on the Second Floor
- Pupils will be asked to hand sanitise on arrival at lessons and will participate in the faculty cleaning of tables/chairs and equipment as previously.
- All PE classes have been outdoors since Mon 19.4.21 and pupils can come to school with suitable clothing
 for outdoor PE. Currently, we are not yet permitted to use indoor changing rooms. However, from
 Monday 26.4.21, indoor PE will be permitted (but not contact sports), but pupils will still not be able to
 use changing room facilities until further guidance is received.
- Break and lunchtime food/drinks/snacks will be available as usual, but pupils will be asked to go outside when they have picked up their snack/lunch.
- Senior pupils will be permitted to attend lunchtime study/drop-in sessions organised by faculty staff.
- There is no requirement for pupils to wear school uniform until after summer.
- Break time will last for 20 mins.
- Lunchtimes will be 45/50 mins each day and on Wed/Thurs/Fri, the school day ends at 2.40pm
- <u>Lateral Flow Test Kits</u> Pupils are able to collect, at lunchtime, 2 test kits from the office each time they
 need new ones. Also, NHS have asked schools to remind parents/carers that LF testing is for
 asymptomatic people only

• Outdoor breaks and lunchtimes:

NHS Grampian have also told schools than any mitigations we can put in place to stop the spread of Coronavirus is really helpful in keeping cases down and schools open. Therefore, this rationale has been applied to outside breaks and lunchtimes, where pupils are safest in an outdoor environment and can take off their masks too. Needless to say, if the weather is inclement, pupils will be permitted to remain indoors in their designated gathering areas. See above.

- Our new Aberdeenshire Quality Improvement Officer for the Ellon Cluster is Mrs F Cruickshanks

Budget Up-date:

Our Year-end spending plan is as follows:

- Purchased 10 new tables for the sunken social area. These tables have fixed seats and can accommodate 8 pupils each and are of much better quality for pupils. They are also foldable and can be easily moved if necessary.
- Purchased additional CCTV cameras in and outside school (Street, Sunken Social Area, Bike Racks and behind games hall)
- o Purchased Maglocks for First Aid Corridor External door
- Purchased additional laptops for ASL Faculty
- Purchased additional whole school devices
- o Purchased VPN laptops for all teaching staff
- o Purchased replacement devices for the Business Education Faculty
- Changed the English Open Learning Area into a teaching space

S6 Leavers:

<u>Yearbook</u> – The S6 Yearbooks have been published and have arrived in school. More details re purchase and distribution to follow.

<u>Hoodies</u> – Pupils are in the process of ordering their Leavers' Hoodies.

Celebration Event – An S6 Leavers event is planned for the first week in June.

<u>Leaving date</u> - More details regarding official leaving date for all school leavers to be established by local and national agreements

Fusion App:

The Fusion App used for pre-ordering school lunches is currently out of operation as a result of technical glitches in the system regarding the new menus which have come online. This is expected to be resolved by the Aberdeenshire Catering Service in approximately one week's time.

Ellon Academy Sports Pitches Up-date:

After 5-6 long years of trying to get our pitches to be playable, after the final stages of remedial work, they will be ready for use after the summer break!

Heating and Ventilation Up-date:

Also, after years of extremes of temperatures in the school, there will be 2 engineers in school for the next few weeks checking every manifold re heating and ventilation in order to compile a report for the Local Authority. There will be no disruption to learning and teaching during this time.

Dates for your diary:

- S4/5/6 (National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher) Assessment Block starts on Mon 26.4.21 and runs for 5 weeks until Fri 28.5.21.
- May Day: Schools will be on holiday on Monday 3rd May.
- Please note there is no Monday holiday on 7th June for the Ellon Cluster Schools
- Additional Inservice days: The Scottish Government have agreed 2 additional in-service days to support school in meeting the SQA requirements for school staff to work on pupil's assessment evidence, draft predicted grades and the quality assurance processes necessary to meet SQA deadlines. It has been agreed that these 2 additional in-service days will be on Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th June.
