Ellon girls took part in an excellent day of football in the Scottish Schools Girls under 14 regional tournament and our girls now progress through to the national finals once again, to be played in May or June in Glasgow. At the local tournament, the girls played 4 games, winning the first 3 with scores of 4-0, 3-0 and 5-0.

The girls played excellent football on the day and went through the whole competition without Amber conceding any goals. The girls constantly threatened going forward and Alisha and Nicole were robust at the back.

Goal scorers today were Myah R (5), Emily S (4), Millie B (2), Natalie G (1), Alisha M 1(), Katie G (1).

Players of the competition today were Myah R, whose attacking display and dribbling was a joy to behold and Emily S, whose first touch and control of the ball in an attacking sense was impressive.

Pupil Achievement:

Last week we had 11 students travelling to Glenrothes in Fife to participate in the Scottish Schools Aquathlon Championships 2023. All pupils participated in the individual event which was as follows:

- S1/2: 250m swim, 2K run
- S3/4: 400m swim, 3k run
- S5/6: 500m swim, 4k run

All pupils showed their exceptional talents and resilience throughout the event and represented Ellon proudly. We had two top 10 finishes with Ella C coming in 2nd place in the Girls S5/6 category (pictured) and Harris C coming in 8th place in the S3/4 category with the 2nd fastest run for his category. Callum U narrowly missed out the top 10 in the S5/6 category coming in 12th after an impressive run.

Following the individual events, 7 of the pupils then went on to participate in the team relay comprising of a 200m swim and 1k run each. Ellon 2 started ahead with a strong leg from Harris C however Ellon 1 managed to catch up with strong runs in the 2nd and 3rd legs from Harris P and James H however couldn't quite catch them and finished 2 seconds behind Ellon 2. The teams finished in 18th and 20th place out of 28 with a very strong field! Well done to all 🏆🏊🏃

'A Kind of Spark' by Elle McNicol



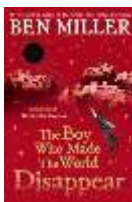

Harrison has a terrible temper. An unusual entertainer gives him his very own black hole. He starts to put things which annoy him in it – he soon regrets some of his decisions though!



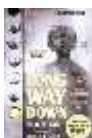
Little People, BIG DREAMS Treasury: 50 Stories from Brilliant Dreamers
